Statement of Purpose

The *Cheylin Schools Foundation Fund* has been established to help the Cheylin School District survive the economic hardship with state budget cuts that have affected schools across the state of Kansas.

Goals

This *Fund* has been established with the goal of assisting with the financial needs that are necessary to continue offering educational and athletic programs at Cheylin USD 103.

Schools across the state are being affected by the state budget cuts, and many schools have had to close their doors due to lack of funding. The Cheylin School District, and the communities involved, want to see Cheylin survive this hardship!

A Bit of History

The Bird City and McDonald communities consolidated schools in 1976. The name Cheylin was formed through consolidating the names of the two counties in which the two communities reside, Cheyenne and Rawlins Counties.

For more than 30 years, Cheylin has had a strong, supportive community, and a history of successful graduates who once walked the halls of Cheylin Schools.

Funding Campaign

The avenue for funding this project is readily available through Bird City Century II Development Foundation, a 501(c)(3) public charity, which allows the highest available tax deductions on contributions.

With the establishment of this *Fund*, Bird City Century II Development Foundation has agreed to absorb all administrative fees and investment fees for two years (through 2012).

Funding Opportunities

Current *Funds* readily available through the Cheylin Schools Foundation Fund:

- *General Operating Fund* - Non-endowed fund for general operating expenses
- *Endowment Fund* - 5% of endowed assets available for spending each year; in perpetuity (forever)
- *Preschool Program Fund* - Non-endowed fund for Cheylin Preschool Program
- *Football Program Fund* - Non-endowed fund for Cheylin Football Program
- *Volleyball Program Fund* - Non-endowed fund for Cheylin Volleyball Program
- *Golf Program Fund* - Non-endowed fund for Cheylin Golf Program

Other *funds* for specific programs can be established with a minimum \$500 donation and the approval of the Cheylin Board of Education. If interested, please contact us for additional information.
